The Orange County Workforce Investment Board (OCWIB) is releasing a Request For Proposals (RFP) for Program Year (PY) 2006-2007 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Youth Program Services on or around January 12, 2006.

The OCWIB is seeking proposals from qualified organizations or individuals to address employment, training needs and skill deficiencies of economically disadvantaged Orange County youth ages 16 to 21 with barriers to employment, as defined in the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) 127(2) (c). Responses to this RFP process will be considered for a funding cycle beginning July 1, 2006.

Proposals must be received by OCWIB staff on March 13, 2006 by 3:00 p.m., in order to be considered for funding.
